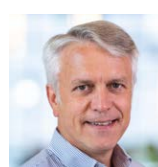

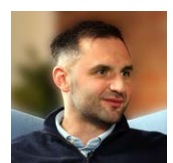


Dr. Steven W. Pipe

His clinical interests include bleeding and thrombotic disorders, and congenital vascular anomalies. He also directs a basic research lab investigating coagulation factor VIII and the molecular mechanisms of haemophilia A. He has been actively involved in clinical trials with novel therapeutics for haemophilia, including gene therapy.
